*"Create-Social-Recources"*  
*02.09.- 09.09.2016, Poronin, Poland*

Create-Social-Recources (CSR) is an international project designed for those involved and engaged in the implementation of youth projects, initiatives and activities involving the activities of young people, particularly from disadvantaged backgrounds, with fewer opportunities, in the context of enlargement / gain knowledge, tools, instruments and the ability to create cooperation with the business sector. The project will be directed, crucially on the issues of CSR (corporate social responsibility).

It will be held in Poronin (Poland) within **02-09.09.2016**. The project will be attended by youth workers, leaders from partner countries **aged 18-30 years**, a total of 26 people (24 participants and 2 facilitators from Poland).

Based on the terminology derived from the European Commission CSR- Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), enterprises, companies and corporations shall endeavor in the context of social and environmental change.

The subject of training contributes to the objectives and priorities of the Erasmus +, which aims to promote cooperation and synergies between actors in the education of young people that use methods of non-formal education (non-governmental organizations, cultural institutions, youth clubs, etc.) And the business sector (companies, firms , corporations).

Training Create-Sustainable-Recources involved in the activities of organizations: **Poland (2), Macedonia, Latvia, Malta, Romania (2), Croatia, Slovenia and the Czech Republic** (maintaining the diversity of geographical, economic and cultural), aims to equip youth workers with the tools, skills and tools related to develop the CSR strategy, which will serve to support existing / implemented youth programs, and will form the basis for new initiatives.

Creating cooperation will be very helpful in the context of improving and increasing the knowledge, competencies, skills of young people and those working directly with them (going beyond the formal education system / school), by creating and implementing innovative programs and tools, methods, programs and educational tools.

Training Course "Create-Social-Recources (CSR)" which will be held in Poronin (Poland), will consist of three basic parts:

- The preparatory period
- Implementation (**2.09.-09.09.2016**)
- dissemination of the project results to the end of its duration.

## **FINANCIAL CONDITIONS**

Transportation costs of all participants will be covered by project budget up to Erasmus + limits of transportation costs for partner countries (look below).

**Transportation is reimbursed up to national limits of travel (look below) on way city of hosting organization - Poronin (venue) - city of hosting organization.**

So all participants (by their partner organization) will have to buy their tickets from home to Poronin (Poland) and **we will pay up to limits of transportation costs per country during project activities by cash.**

All costs related to accommodation, and food (3 meals per day “breakfast, lunch, supper”) will be covered by Project budget as well. We will not pay preparation costs for partner organizations since it will be contribution from side of partner organizations as we already informed before project application.

Limits of transportation costs for partner countries are:

All amounts above are amounts provided for participant's own contribution! Example for Macedonian participants - plane tickets purchased for 300 euros, will be reimbursed in the amount of 275 euros (with the option of shuttle bus – for example cost of shuttle bus from Krakow to Poronin is 15 Euro per participant. Participant spent 300 Euro for tickets, the limit is 275 Euro, but we, as a host organization paid for shuttle bus, we will take 15 Euro from limit of 275 Euro – so participant will get 260 Euro).

-Participants from **Czech Republic 180€ (only on the distance: Brno-Poronin)** will be reimbursed **per participant**  
total %100 for whole group (**2 participants**) will be 360€ (max.)

-Participants from **Croatia 180€ (only on the distance: Zagreb- Poronin)** will be reimbursed **per participant**  
total %100 for whole group (**3 participants**) will be 540€ (max.)

-Participants from **Romania 275€ (only on the distance: Bacau-Poronin)** will be reimbursed **per participant**  
total %100 for whole group (**3 participants**) will be 825€ (max.)

-Participants from **Romania 275€ (only on the distance: Moieciu-Poronin)** will be reimbursed **per participant**  
total %100 for whole group (**3 participants**) will be 825€ (max.)

-Participants from **Macedonia 275€ (only on the distance: Bitola-Poronin)** will be reimbursed **per participant**  
total %100 for whole group (**2 participants**) will be 550€ (max.)

-Participants from **Latvia 275€** (only on the distance: Riga- Poronin) will be reimbursed **per participant**

total %100 for whole group (**2 participants**) will be 550€ (max.)

-Participants from **Malta 275€** (only on the distance: Naxxar- Poronin) will be reimbursed **per participant**

total %100 for whole group (**2 participants**) will be 550€ (max.)

-Participants from **Slovenia 180€** (only on the distance: Selnica ob Dravi- Poronin) will be reimbursed **per participant**

total %100 for whole group (**2 participants**) will be 360€ (max.)

-Participants from **Poland 180€** (only on the distance: Zgierz-Poronin) will be reimbursed **per participant**

total %100 for whole group (**3 participants**) will be 540 € (max.)

-Participants from **Poland 180€** (only on the distance: Będzin-Poronin) will be reimbursed **per participant** total %100 for whole group (**4 participants**) will be 720 € (max.)

**Before buying tickets – ask us about travel plan!**

**Tickets can be purchased from 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2016, NOT EARLIER!!!**

**(We will not reimburse for tickets that were bought before this date)**

**Boarding passes are obligatory as well.**

## TRANSPORTATION

Poronin is easy to reach from big cities like Kraków or Katowice.

We offer You two options.

-First- we will provide transportation from airport to venue (Poronin). In this situation Your limits of transportation costs for partner countries will be a bit lower (when you exceeded

the travel cost limit). We will have to pay for shuttle buses.

-Second- You will be obligated to reach venue by Yourself. There are buses and trains from Katowice and Kraków to Zakopane (from Zakopane to Poronin you need to take a taxi). So feel free to check connections from all these cities since we have limited budget for all groups. If you will come to different cities please contact with us about transportation issues for to support you during whole process.

Photos will be taken during project by our team as well and at the end of the project we will share on-line with all partner organizations before departure.
